- The children will be in a class group of 26 children with one teacher and one nursery assistant.
- The well being of your child and your family are important to us.
- You will be welcome to join your child at the 'Meet and Greet' Session, and at the 'Stay and Play' session at the start of Term 1.
- We will share your child's learning journey with you and keep you informed about how your child is settling in.
- We will build up your child's time at school when your child is ready and when routines are in place.
- We want to work in partnership with you, the parent and appreciate your support.
- The 'Getting Started' in Magherafelt Nursery School handbook will provide you with key information about the school.

Stay and Play Session Term 1





- This is a special day for you and your child and we encourage you to join in with the play activities.
- You are your child's first educator and you know your child best so tell us about your child.
- Each 'Stay and Play' session will last for 1 hour and will have a small pod of children.
- Two parents may attend but no older / younger siblings on this occasion (babies excepted).
- · We will aim to answer any questions that you have.
- We will give you 'An All About Me' booklet which you can complete at home and return.
- You will receive a Policy Summary and you will have some data capture forms to complete and return.
- We encourage you to add a family photo to the 'All About Me' booklet or send it to the school email address.

What do I need to bring for my child?



- Full set of spare clothing
- Box of tissues
- Care Plan and Medication from your GP / Consultant if your child has a medical condition.
- £25 School Fund at your earliest convenience.
- School bags are not needed.

Mrs Walker is our Senior Clerical Officer and she works hard to keep the school administration flowing and to keep you up to date with nursery events.




Mr Whiteside is our Building Supervisor and he takes great pride in his work, keeping our school sparkling and clean and doing lots of DIY jobs!

What To Wear to School

We do not have a uniform but make sure that your child wears practical clothing that is suitable for playing in both indoors and out!





With 130 active children in the building, clothing can get mixed up! Put child's name on shoes, jumpers, coats, hats, gloves and snood.

Top Tips for Settling into Nursery Life

- Make sure that your child can use the bathroom as independently as possible.
- Teach your child to use a tissue and to put it in the bin.
- Talk to your child about the names of the teacher and assistant.
- Give your child experiences of being away from you before starting school.
- Each child has his / her own personality so try not to compare your child with others!
- Read all messages, emails and texts.
- Trust the staff and get to know them as best you can.





Settling In

Stay and Play

Two parents are welcome and must stay with your child for the duration of the session so that you can introduce your child to the play activities and get to know the teacher and assistant.

Day I in week commencing 5th / 12th September. Give your child a cuddle and tell him / her that you have a job to do and will be back soon.

Follow the Settling In Plan for your child and be guided by the teacher who will let you know how your child is getting on.

Child Led Learning







It is the teacher's role to:

- Extend and widen the learning as children play and explore together.
- Develop and deepen the language experiences.
- Encourage, motivate and support the play experiences.
- Observe and document the progress of each child.

Teacher Led Learning







The teacher and assistant will:

- Make handwashing and hygiene a regular part of the school day.
- Encourage the children to get to know each other.
- Set up structured activities for all children to experience.
- Lead group activities such as craft, Eco tasks, planting seeds, circle time, story time and physical activity.
- Teach songs, rhymes, drama and dance.




Rhythm and beat Fast and slow, loud and soft
